Revealing the Heart Monument at the Government House

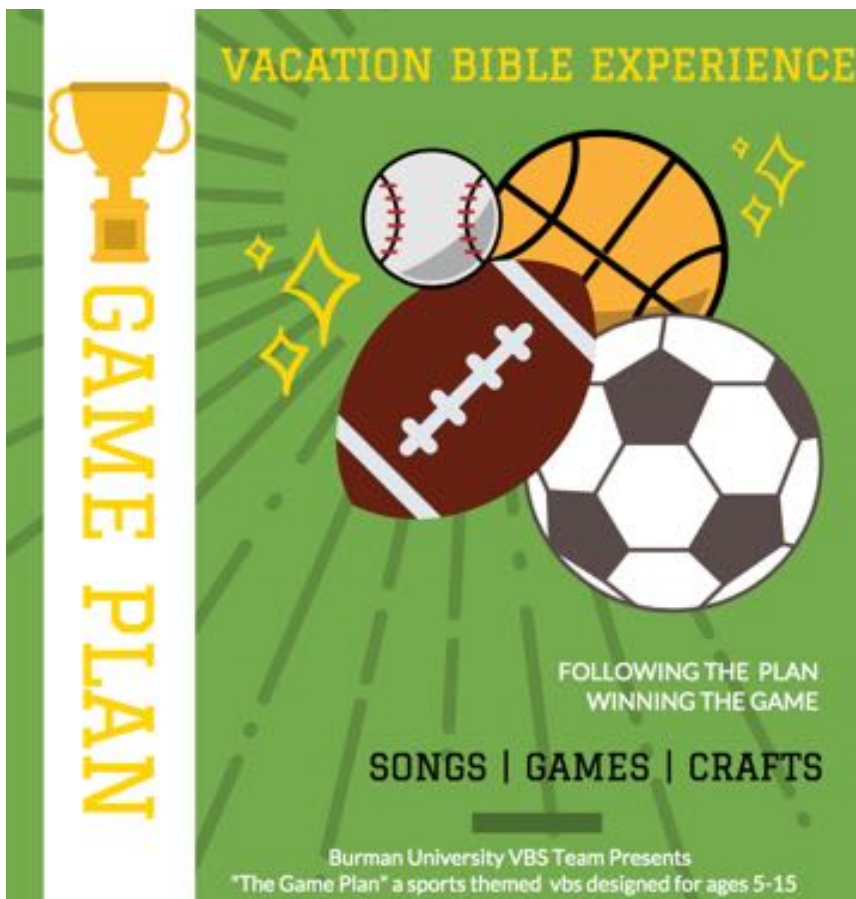

Present were members from the Native Community, Premier Dwight Ball, and the Honourable Judy Foote. This unveiling was in honour of all the Native children who were taken from their families, communities, culture and native language and forced into dormitories, dress codes, European culture, and denied fundamental human rights. A special garden was created with five sections, each one representing one of the first nations communities in NL. It was a service to reflect, appreciate, and commit to equality of peoples around us.

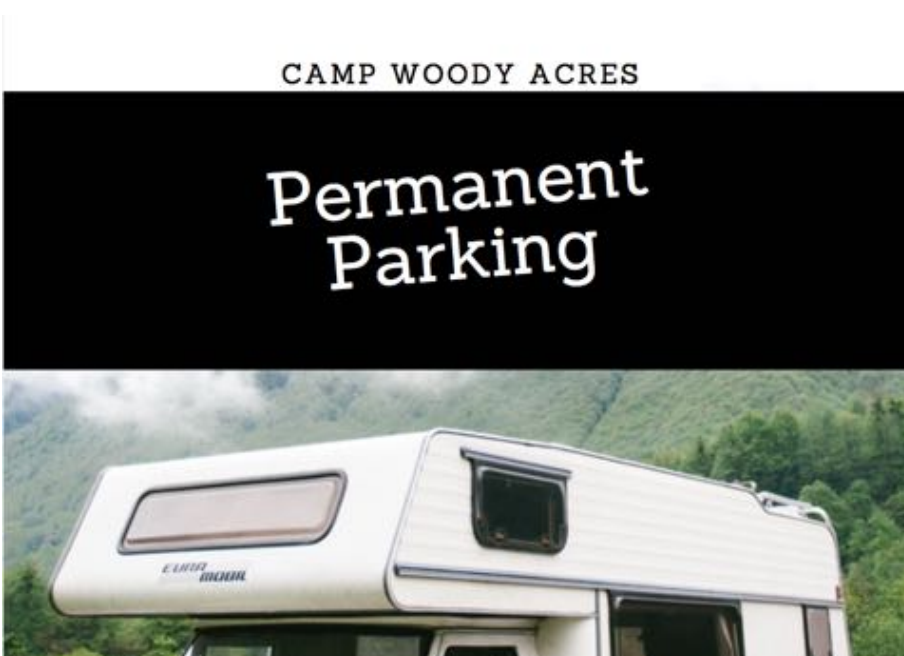
If you wish to save on purchasing, you can split a case cost with another person; this will have to be arranged between yourselves.
