NL Adventist President Ken Corkum Attends Opening of New Session of NL Parliament

On Tuesday March 13, Pastor Ken Corkum, NL Adventist president, attended the opening of the third session of the 48th General Assembly of the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador to listen to the Speech from the Throne of Lieutenant Governor Frank Fagan. The Speech from the Throne officially opens every new session of Parliament.

The leading clergy of NL sat in special seating between the Provincial parties with the Opposition party on the left, with Leader Paul Davis of the Progressive Conservatives, and on the right, the governing Liberal party with

Premier Dwight Ball in the center of the picture (showing the right side of center section).

The speech, which went on for some 45 minutes, presented the visioning and specific objectives of the Liberal party, for the next year and beyond. Updates were given on present projects like Muskrat Falls, including the comment that the project is 90% finished and the connecting transmission lines, between NL and NS, are now complete.

Commenting on his experience at the event, Pastor Corkum stated, "I have been impressed how the NL Government respects and includes the religious leaders of NL in their important events."
