Additionally, Pastor Jonathan Gascoyne, as the volunteer Corrections Chaplain for the Facility, regularly ministers to the inmates through Bible study, prayer, visitation, and a variety of other creative services.

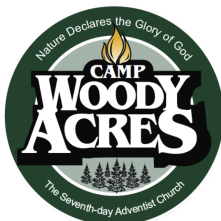

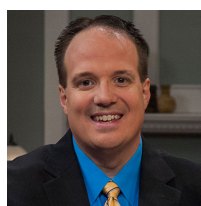
**DES CUMMINGS JR.**, Seminar Speaker-The Beauty of the Sabbath
