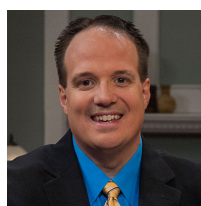
**DES CUMMINGS JR.**, Seminar Speaker-The Beauty of the Sabbath
