

Jayden Purcell is an 11-year-old member of the St. John's Seventh-day Adventist Church. For those who do not know Jayden; he is a fun-loving, adventurous, considerate, witty child who through many surgeries and trials has never lost faith in a loving and allpowerful God. Jayden, along with his Sister Noelle, believes with all their heart that God has a reason why he is facing so many tests. Jayden Purcell was born with a heart condition that has left him with many complications throughout his young life. However, you cannot be sorrowful around Jayden because he's full of joy! Currently, the conduit in place for his pulmonary artery is 90% blocked, and the stent is not working. This blockage is not allowing oxygenated blood to travel properly around his body. Jayden's mom says, "This blockage now means we have to travel to the sick kids' hospital in Toronto, where Jayden will have open heart surgery to repair these issues. This is Jayden's 8th heart surgery and 3rd open heart. All prayers are appreciated. Jenny, Hughie, and Noelle have always been by Jayden's' side through everything and pray for him continually.
