Greetings to the Newfoundland family from Corner Brook!

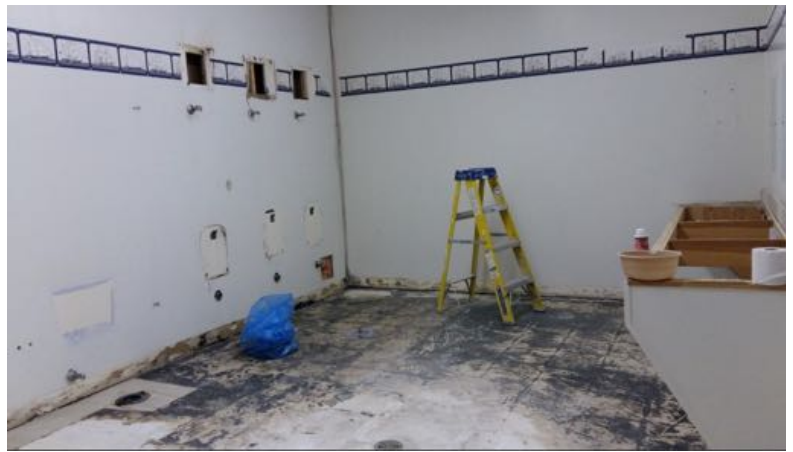

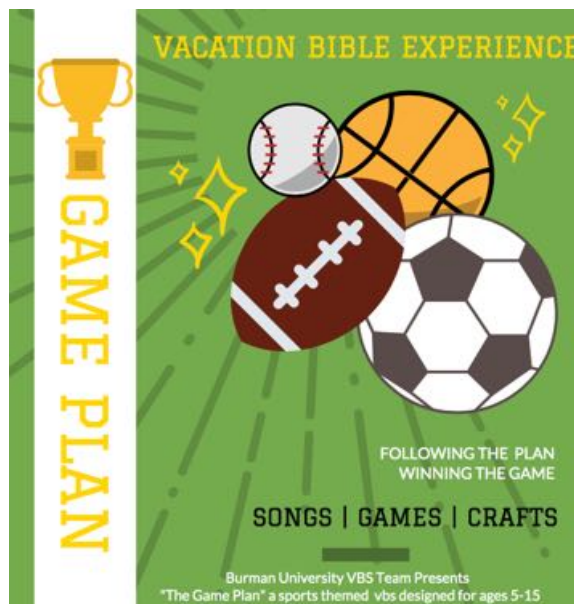
The dates for this years' program are:

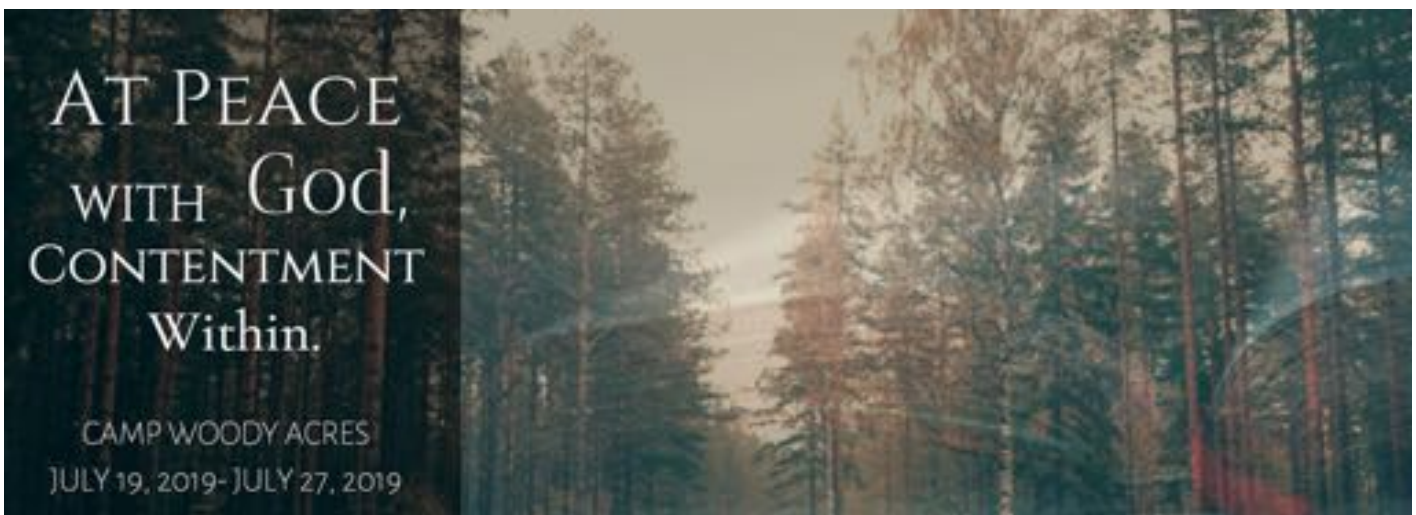

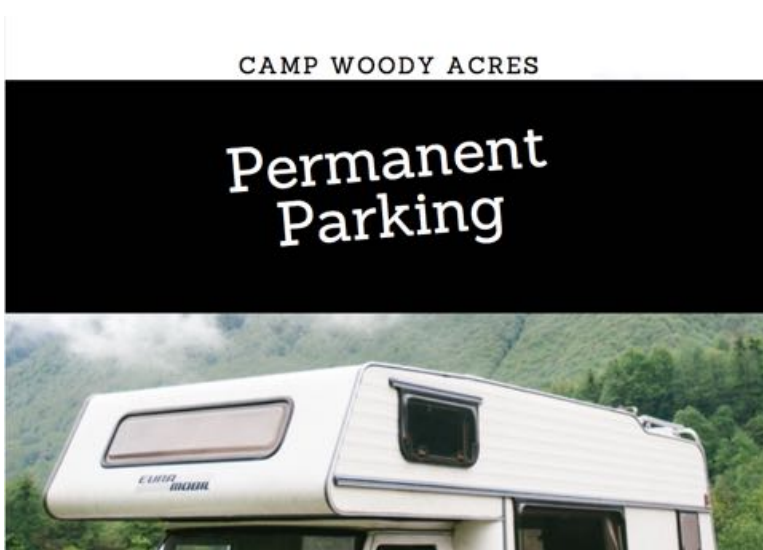
