
Tuesday Night Bible Studies

Stuffed At the Gill's

Cook about 6 to 8 lasagna noodles. While noodles are cooking make filling.

Filling:

8 medium potatoes cooked, and mashed ¼ cup milk ½ cup sour cream ¼ cup butter (can use less) ½ pound cheddar cheese, shredded (about 2 ½ cups shredded or half a 500 gram block) Salt and pepper to taste




Topping:

Sauté in margarine or oil 3-4 onions, chopped (about 3-4 cups)

Put casserole together as follows:

Layer in a well buttered 9"x13" dish, starting at the bottom and going up (see diagram):



- noodles (bottom)
- potato filling (middle)
- noodles (top)
- sautéed onions (topping)
- ¼ cup of simulated bacon bits (optional topping)

Cover with foil and bake at 350 degrees for ½ hour or until hot through. Serve with sour cream and bacon bits.
