The church was able to serve 82 individuals, all of whom were low income and unemployed. The church also started a community garden and used some of the produce for its food hamper program.

Labrador Friendship Centre and Libra House, serving the Inuit, Innu and Metis communities. and domestic violence victims. respectively, received assistance.
