
It is with much joy that I share that on Tuesday, April 26, we signed the counteroffer to purchase the Carnell Property adjacent to our office, as authorized by the NL Board of Directors. The closing date for the purchase is June 30, 2022. The new office will mean that both VOAR Lighthouse-FM and the NL Mission Administration can work together on the upper floor of a quality building. It has been over a 10-year journey to arrive at a place where we can replace our aging building, which has served us well. The purchase of the existing facility is a significant cost saving compared to building our own new complex. A new building would have involved:

- High costs for consultants.
- Bringing in water and sewer services.
- Landscaping with a paved parking lot.

There will be renovations in our new building and a due-diligence list to be met, however, the process has begun. May the Lord be with His Church in Newfoundland and Labrador as we work together to take the good news of the three angels message to the people of our Province.

Sunday, July 31st - Wednesday, August 3rd


Caring for Kids Camp: This will be a single-day camp sponsored by local businesses for a local group to come to enjoy the activities offered by our Camp.
