

LETHBRIDGE SDA CHURCH




Other games such as Uno, Jenga, and Scrabble were played throughout the night.


In June 2019, the members of the Corner Brook Church unanimously voted to sell their facility and begin a journey to find a more suitable and cost-efficient meeting place.
